SPEAKING AND WRITING SKILLS (LEVEL 4)

General description and objectives

The course is made up of small groups and involves two-hour classes twice a week. Students take Spanish Grammar Level 4 concurrently.

Content

- Talking about habits in the present. Relating past experiences. Talking about the beginning and duration of an action. Positioning actions in time.
- Prohibitions and obligations. Talking about Spanish habits.
- Talking about habits, customs and circumstances in the past tenses. Arguing and debating.
- Offering recommendations and advice. Giving instructions. Describing a scene in the past and present.
- Using the telephone. Taking and leaving telephone messages.
- Telling stories in the past
- Requesting and granting things, favours and permission. Making excuses and showing gratitude.
- Talking about future actions and situations. Expressing conditions. Drawing up hypotheses.

Assessment

- Final exam (40% of the final mark)
 - Written and oral mid-term exam (20%)
 - Written and oral final exam (20%)
- Continuous assessment (60% of the final mark)
 - Active and productive participation in class (20%)
 - Homework: four written tasks (20%)
 - Oral presentation in front of the class in the last week of the course (20%)
