Assessment procedures and criteria 2024-25

EVALUATION SYSTEM. According to the existing rules of the UA, the overall evaluation of students will be the titration result obtained in the final test next to that reached in the ongoing evaluation. The weight of the final test in the qualification of the subject corresponds to 50% of the final grade (5 points).

Learning evaluation criteria will be:

1. Know and properly manage the concepts of the subject
2. Pinpoint the places explained in class
3. Understand and analyze the major changes taking place in different regions of the world
4. Critically analyze the information collected on different regions of the world.
5. Be able to produce (written and oral) consistent and accurate discourse on the processes and changes that take place in different regions of the world.
6. Participation in scheduled activities.

Remarks:

- 3 spelling mistakes in the final test of the subject can mean a reduction of 20% of the mark. One or two faults may include proportional reductions of the qualification. More than three may be enough to fail the course.

-According to the criteria laid down by the regulations, it will be necessary to overcome a 4 out of 10 or 2 out of 5 on the exam (final evaluation) to add the qualification obtained in the continuous evaluation. If the qualification obtained in the final examination was not equal to or greater than 4, the subject will be suspended. In the case of not fulfilling any of the minimum requirements established in the teaching guide, although the sum of the qualifications of the evaluation activities is higher than 4.5, the overall grade of the subject will be 4.5.

- In the call C3, the continuous assessment tests on control of place names will be recoverable. The mark of the last test taken will be kept. This will be held the day of evaluation established by the Board of the faculty. Face-to-face group practices are not recoverable in this call

-If the student doesn't pass the examination of the call C3 (June), corresponding to the continuous assessment grades (classroom practices and control of place names) will be retained for the C4 call (July). The exam will have to be taken, even if the grade obtained in C3 was higher than 2 out of 5 or 4 out of 10

-Those students who have not completed the course at the first evaluation (C3) can repeat the tests on place names in the second call (C4) controls. This will take place the day of evaluation established by the Board of the faculty. The mark of the last test taken will be kept. Group practices will not be recoverable in the C4 call.

-Continuous evaluation ratings are not preserved for the following academic year.

-The qualification relating to observation and participation in class (5% of the grade corresponding to continuous evaluation) will correspond to attendance at practical classes. An attendance check will be carried out.

- It will be established for students that if any of the circumstances referred to in the regulation adapting the curriculum, an alternative assessment procedure

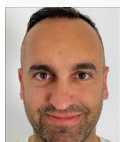
