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COMMUNICATION

Communication and Social Media Assistant

Intern assists in a football science institute offering master programs to sports medicine and training professionals, helping the community manager. Commuting to the placement by bus or subway is required. Public transportation fares are not included in the program.

Level of Spanish required: All Levels

Other requisites: experience with social media, knowledge of photo/video editing software

Schedule of placement: 9AM-3PM

Tasks:

- Create content for social media.
- Help community manager in their functions.
- Help develop marketing strategies.

Outcomes:

- Work experience in sports science field
- Work experience in social media management
- Deeper knowledge of the Spanish business and education system
- Adaptation to new cultural and work systems.
- Ability to adapt to change.
- Understanding cultural differences in the workplace.
- Ability to work in groups.

Writing Department Assistant at a Local Newspaper

Intern assists in the main local newspaper at the writing department. Tasks will vary depending on the interests and skills of the intern. Commuting to the placement by bus is required. Public transportation fares are not included in the program.

Level of Spanish required: High-intermediate.

Schedule of placement: 9AM-3PM (partly remote)

Tasks:

- Create content for the newspaper's website.
- Develop personal projects.
- Shadow reporters while they're working.

Outcomes:

- Work experience in communications and media field
- Deeper knowledge of the Spanish media, both written and online
- Adaptation to new cultural and work systems.
- Ability to adapt to change.
- Understanding cultural differences in the workplace.
- Appreciation of other cultures

EDUCATION

Day Care Assistant

Intern assists in a bilingual center for children aged 0-3, helping familiarize children with the English language. The center includes classrooms and a play center.

Level of Spanish required: All Levels

Schedule of placement: Morning/Afternoon

Tasks:

- Interact with children; play with them, feed them, talk to them, teach basic English.
- Help preschool teachers organize activities.
- Speak English to children in order to enhance language immersion.
- In some cases, provide support during extracurricular activities such as English classes, in the play center, or during celebrations.

Outcomes:

- Ability to adapt to change.
- Adaptation to new cultural and educational systems.
- Work experience in the childcare field.
- Understanding of cultural differences in the workplace.
- Ability to work individually and in groups.
- Appreciation of other cultures.

Teaching Assistant: Pre-school, Primary and Secondary Education

Interns at all levels of Spanish language ability can intern in local schools with students aged 3 to 18 years old. Schools are bilingual and many classes are held in English. Interns start by observing classes, then gradually begin to assist instructors. Interns main task is enhancing local students' immersion into English by speaking in class and providing support, with the goal of improving students' listening and speaking skills. Depending on the experience and approval, instructors may allow interns to organize activities or teach a class by themselves.

Level of Spanish required: All Levels.

Schedule of placement: 8:30am to 2:30pm

Tasks:

- Observe classes, taught in English, at primary/secondary schools.
- Help instructor organize activities.
- Speak English in class to contribute to students' language immersion.
- In some cases, teach a class.
- In some cases, provide support during extracurricular activities such as workshops, celebrations, or excursions.

Outcomes:

- Acquisition of teaching methods.
- Ability to adapt to change.
- Adaptation to new academic, cultural, and educational systems.
- Work experience in education.
- Understanding of cultural differences in the workplace.
- Ability to work individually and in groups.
- Appreciation of other cultures.

HEALTH SCIENCE

Intern with General Practitioner

Interns observe a general practitioner as she interacts with patients, including consultation, diagnosis, and treatment. Interns will learn how to identify and treat symptoms/illnesses.

Level of Spanish required: Advanced

Other requisites: Academic background in health sciences

Schedule information: Monday to Thursday from 8:30am to 12:30pm and 5:30pm to 8:30pm.

Tasks:

- Observe the general practitioner.
- Act as a translator when the patient is a foreigner.
- Analyze symptoms.
- Provide assistance when identifying illness.
- Auscultate patients when needed.

Outcomes:

- Work experience in the healthcare field.
- Deeper knowledge of symptomatology.
- Deeper knowledge of medical treatments.
- Deeper knowledge of pharmacology.
- Adaptation to new cultural and work systems.
- Adaptation to the Spanish health care system.
- Ability to adapt to changes.
- Understanding of cultural differences in the workplace.
- Ability to work in a group.
- Appreciation of other cultures.

Psychological Assistance to People with Mental Disorders

Interns organize and participate in workshops to help patients with mental disorders. Workshop topics may include techniques for control of stress, relaxation, laughter therapy, English language, social skills, and reading. Interns may also help organize and implement campaigns designed to increase awareness, and participate in sporting events with patients. Depending on language level and educational background, interns may attend meetings and seminars for patients' families.

Level of Spanish required: Intermediate

Other requisites: Academic background in psychology preferred

Schedule information: Wednesday evening and Tuesday or Thursday morning.

Tasks:

- Organize English classes for patients.
- Organize and/or participate in workshops with center staff.
- Accompany patients to and participate in sport activities.
- Attend meetings and seminars with patients' families.

Outcomes:

- Work experience in psychology and social services fields.
- Deeper knowledge of psychology and social services.
- Adaptation to new cultural and work systems.
- Adaptation to the Spanish social services system.
- Ability to adapt to change.
- Understanding cultural differences in the workplace.
- Ability to work in a group.
- Appreciation of other cultures.

SOCIAL SERVICES

Assistant at Center for At-Risk Youth

Interns help organize activities for youth experiencing socio-familiar difficulties. The center operates as a primary and secondary school and also provides housing and support services. The center is located outside the city, so transportation is needed. The round-trip ticket cost is approximately 2.5€, to be paid by the intern.

Spanish level required: Intermediate.

Other requirements: Social work experience and/or academic background in psychology or education

Schedule information: Morning/Afternoon/Evening

Tasks:

- Organize English classes.
- Assist the English teacher in class.
- Organize and/or participate in other workshops under supervision.
- Participate in sport or social activities under supervision.

Outcomes:

- Work experience in the fields of social services and social education.
- Deeper knowledge of social services in Spain.
- Adaptation to new cultural and work systems.
- Adaptation to the Spanish social services system.
- Ability to adapt to change and challenges.
- Understanding cultural differences in the workplace.
- Ability to work in groups and individually.

Assistant at Local International Cooperation NGO

This Non-Governmental Organization works on projects in Africa and Asia. Interns assist with administrative tasks, translate texts, and help with fundraising activities, among other duties.

Level of Spanish required: Intermediate.

Schedule information: Morning/Afternoon

Tasks:

- Provide assistance with administrative tasks (filing, data entry, sending documentation).
- Interns with advanced Spanish skills help translate documents or parts of the website into English.
- Help stock handicrafts for fundraising.

Outcomes:

- Work experience in NGO/international cooperation field.
- Deeper knowledge of the Spanish international cooperation system.
- Adaptation to new cultural and work systems.
- Ability to adapt to change.
- Understanding cultural differences in the workplace.
- Ability to work in groups.
- Appreciation of other cultures.

Social Services Assistant for the Elderly

Interns work with an institution that provides care to elderly people by keeping them company, engaging in activities with them, or completing caregiving tasks. Each intern will be assigned one elderly person and will meet twice a week to provide company and care, and encourage them to stay active.

Level of Spanish required: High-intermediate.

Schedule information: Two hours in the evening, twice a week

Tasks:

- Provide company to an elderly person.
- Listen to the elderly person, since most live alone and need someone to talk to.
- Depending on academic background and working experience, complete caregiving tasks.
- Take the elderly person for a walk.
- Accompany the elderly person to the doctor, grocery store, administration offices, etc.
- Organize workshops for the elderly person (IT, cell phone use, etc.).

Outcomes:

- Work experience in the elder care field.
- Deeper knowledge of the Spanish social services system.
- Adaptation to new cultural and work systems.
- Adaptation to the Spanish social services system.
- Ability to adapt to change.

Personal Care Assistant

Interns assist people with cerebral palsy in their daily tasks. Interns learn from the patients' needs and from the professionals who look after them.

Level of Spanish required: Intermediate.

Schedule information: Morning/Afternoon

Tasks:

- Provide assistance in the dining room.
- Provide assistance with grooming.
- Provide assistance with swimming activities.
- Teach how to use public transportation.

Outcomes:

- Work experience in the personal care field.
- Deeper knowledge of the Spanish social services system.
- Adaptation to new cultural and work systems.
- Ability to adapt to change.
- Understanding cultural differences in the workplace.
- Ability to work in groups.

TOURISM

Hotel Reception Assistant

Interns provide reception assistance at a centrally located hotel and learn about hotel management. Granada draws many tourists, and working at a centrally located hotel allows interns to experience the tourism industry first-hand.

Spanish level required: Intermediate.

Schedule information: Morning/Afternoon/Evenings

Tasks:

- Provide assistance during check-in and check-out.
- Invoicing.
- Manage bookings.
- Provide tourist information to customers.
- Help procure tickets to attractions.
- Solve room issues.
- Provide customer service.

Outcomes:

- Work experience in the hospitality field in a popular tourist destination.
- Deeper knowledge and adaptation to the Spanish hospitality industry.
- Adaptation to new cultural and work systems.
- Ability to adapt to change.
- Understanding cultural differences in the workplace.
- Ability to work in groups.
