SPEAKING AND WRITING SKILLS (LEVEL 3)

General description and objectives

The course is made up of small groups and involves two-hour classes twice a week. Students take Spanish Grammar Level 3 concurrently. This subject will mainly deal with communicative competence so that students achieve the profile required for this level.

Content

- Talking about duration. Motivation and intention. Talking about learning problems and difficulties. Making recommendations.
- Expressing likes. Expressing coincidence. Locating. Comparisons.
- Describing physical appearance. Measuring. Identifying. Talking about similarities. Talking about relationships.
- Expressing actions happening while speaking. Addressing someone formally or informally. Getting by in bars.
- Speaking about timetables. Talking about past experiences. Describing places. Talking about intentions and projects.
- Talking about eating habits. Explaining a recipe.
- Telling someone's biography. Relating past events.
- Expressing desire to do something. Appreciation in the past. Talking about aches, pains and symptoms.

Assessment

- Final exam (40% of the final mark)
 - Written and oral mid-term exam (20%)
 - Written and oral final exam (20%)
- Continuous assessment (60% of the final mark)
 - Active and productive participation in class (20%)
 - Homework: three written tasks (20%)
 - Oral presentation in front of the class in the last week of the course (20%)
